Website User Privacy Notice

We inform you that, while browsing or consulting this website, our organization may collect and process personal data in accordance with applicable privacy and data protection laws, namely Legislative Decree 196/2003 and EU Regulation 679/2016 (GDPR).

1. Data Controller

2. Processing, Nature of Data, Purpose, Legal Basis, and Retention Period

a) Browsing Data

- **Nature:** During normal operation, this website's IT systems automatically collect certain personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. These data are anonymous but could potentially identify users through processing and combination with data held by third parties. This includes IP addresses, domain names, requested URI addresses, request times, request methods, file sizes, server response codes, operating system and computing environment parameters.
- **Purpose:** Ensure correct website functioning.
- **Legal Basis:** Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR – “processing is necessary for the legitimate interests of the controller or a third party.” Both the organization and the user have a legitimate interest to ensure proper and secure website operation.
- **Retention:** 6 months

b) External Links

- **Nature:** Browsing data (as above)

- **Purpose:** Allow users to navigate to third-party sites for additional information or services. Users will notice the transition via design, new pages, or new cookie banners.
- **Legal Basis:** Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR – legitimate interest of both the organization and the user in accessing new content.
- **Retention:** 6 months

c) Voluntary Data Provided by Email

- **Nature:** Name, contact details (e.g., email), and any other information provided in the message.
- **Purpose:** Manage correspondence and requests between the user and the organization.
- **Legal Basis:** Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR – legitimate interest in properly handling communications.
- **Retention:** Up to 10 years, consistent with Italian statutory retention periods.

d) Contact Forms

- **Nature:** Name, contact details, and other information provided in the form fields.
- **Purpose:** Respond to specific user requests.
- **Legal Basis:** Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR – user consent for processing data for a specific purpose.
- **Retention:** 6 months
